Hazard Mitigation

A core component of increasing a community's resilience to natural hazards is a top-down dedication to continued hazard mitigation. There are many scales of hazard mitigation based on the needs and severity of seasonal and annual hazards. For State, County, and Local organizations, dedicating funding to hazard mitigation projects in preparation for hazards is crucial for mitigating financial and environmental loss from a hazard event. For community leaders, focusing resources that assist the most vulnerable community members with hazard mitigation improvements helps to increase the whole community's resilience. For property owners, understanding the risks to their property increases their agency for protecting their home from local hazards. The resources listed below, while not comprehensive, provide potential tools and funding assistance for communities to evaluate their level of fire adaptation.
