\$5.3 million in Additional Projects Proposed

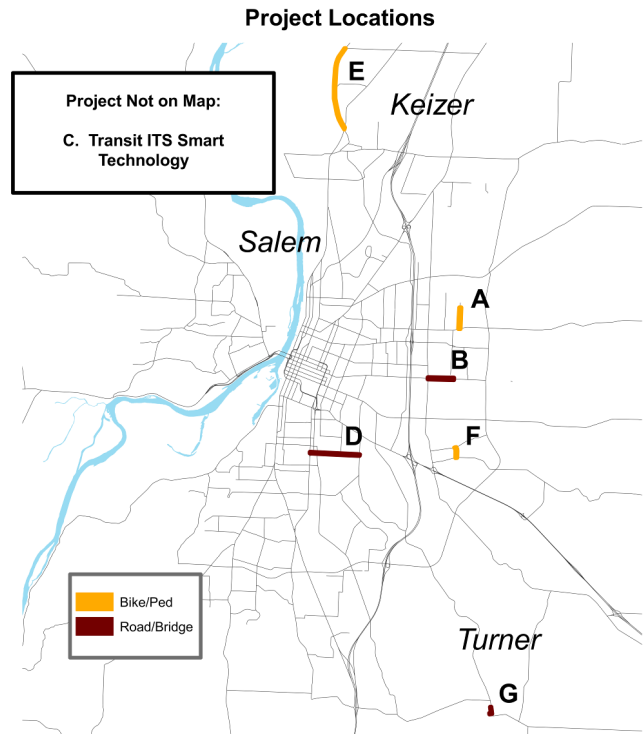
Why this proposed amendment?

In mid-2017, approximately \$5.6 million in federal funding become available.

Projects in the proposed amendment:

- A. Brown Rd: Sidewalk and Bike Lanes completion
- B. Center St: Lancaster Dr to 45th Pl - New Sidewalk and Bike Lane on north side
- C. SAMTD Transit: ITS/Smart Technology Project (operational & safety elements)
- D. McGilchrist St: Complete Street Project - funds for Right-of-Way purchase
- E. Wheatland Rd: Multi-modal Corridor Study and Conceptual Street Design
- F. Connecticut Av: Macleay Rd to Rickey St - West Side Bike Lanes and Sidewalks
- G. Turner Rd: Downtown Urban Upgrade - design funds
